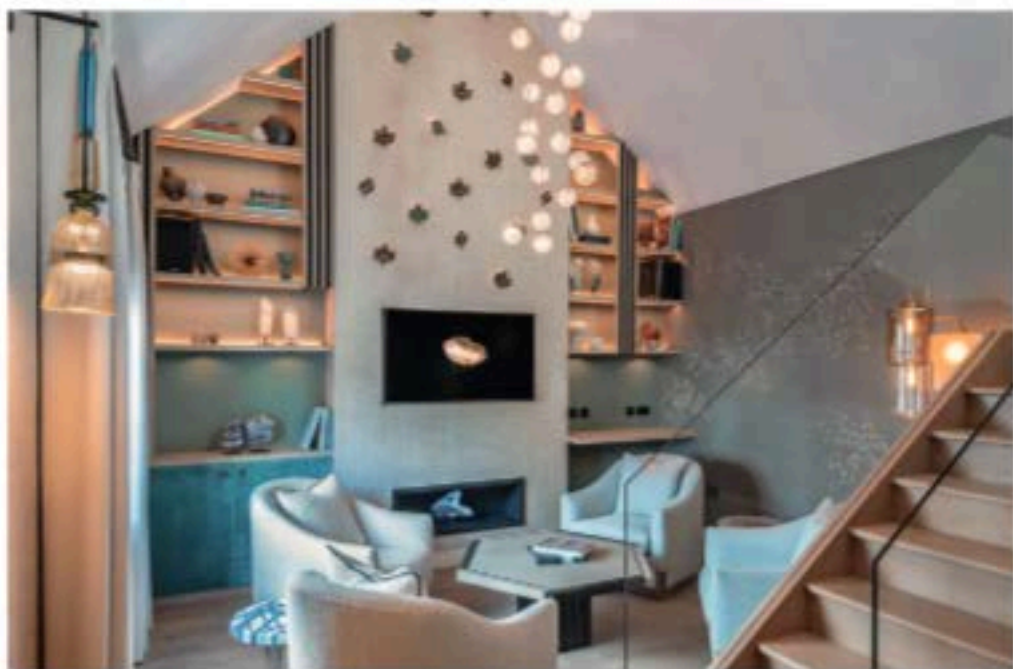

## That glowing feeling

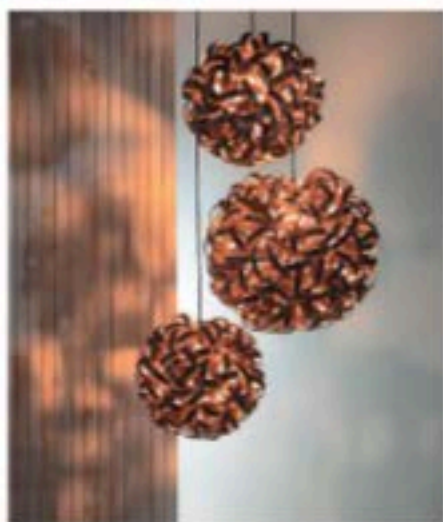
